Part Two: Organization and Management

Administration and Management

In 1994, CSD employed about 37 staff of which 20 professional and 17 support. The high quality and dedication of all its staff certainly made possible the results achieved. Proper financial management and accurate recordkeeping contributed to Center's overall efficiency and control. In its effort towards good governance transparency, the Center and underwent its first external audit related to 1992 and 1993. This audit was sponsored and commissioned by the Private Center for International Enterprise (CIPE) and carried out by Coopers & Lybrand. Again with CIPE's sponsorship, the external audit for 1994 has been assigned to Price Waterhouse; their independent opinion and CSD's financial statements for the year follow.

The Center is placing a particular emphasis its organizational on structure and internal communications. Because of its diverse activities and areas of research, CSD believes that streamlined administrative and are procedures management an important prerequisite for the efficient implementation of its projects.

Senior staff and project coordinators met on a regular basis and monthly lists of regular and special activities and highlights were prepared and distributed. Financial and administrative regulations were drafted to assist management and staff in their daily operational tasks. other, Among guidelines and rules concerning procurement of goods and services, staff qualification and remuneration and official travel, were involved.

Some improvements to the premises that host the Center were made during 1994 such as the acquisition of new furniture and shelving for the library.

Management consultancy for capacity building, sponsored by a USAID project grant, was carried out by Mr Pasquale Ferraro, Deputy Director and Head of Administration and Finance of the International Development Law Institute (IDLI), Rome. Mr Ferraro, an expert on management of non-profit organizations implemented consultancy during a series of three visits to the Center to advise structure and governance, financial planning and accounting, control and audit procedures and fundraising Particular attention strategy. devoted to methodologies concerning internal communications in order to enhance information sharing and staff motivation. A calendar of possible management and staff meetings was suggested. In light of the positive results achieved, a fourth visit is planned for early 1995.

Finance

CSD's financial performance for 1994 was very good. Revenues deriving from grants and contributions, projects and publications were about 32 million leva. Total expenses for the year were about 20 million leva. This led to an excess of revenue over expenses of about 12 million leva mainly attributable to cost effectiveness and the increase of the dollar value against the leva. CSD receives most of its support in dollars, while most of its expenses are in local currency.

The Center's long-term plan towards

sustainability includes consolidation of structure The its and systems. acquisition of premises and information technology fundamental part of this plan. To achieve this, CSD's Governing Board authorized the creation of Endowment Fund to which most of the Center's excess at year-end, if any, will be allocated. Also, CSD plans to encourage its sponsors to make contributions towards its Endowment Fund, thus encouraging self-support and long-term planning of its activities and institutional growth.
